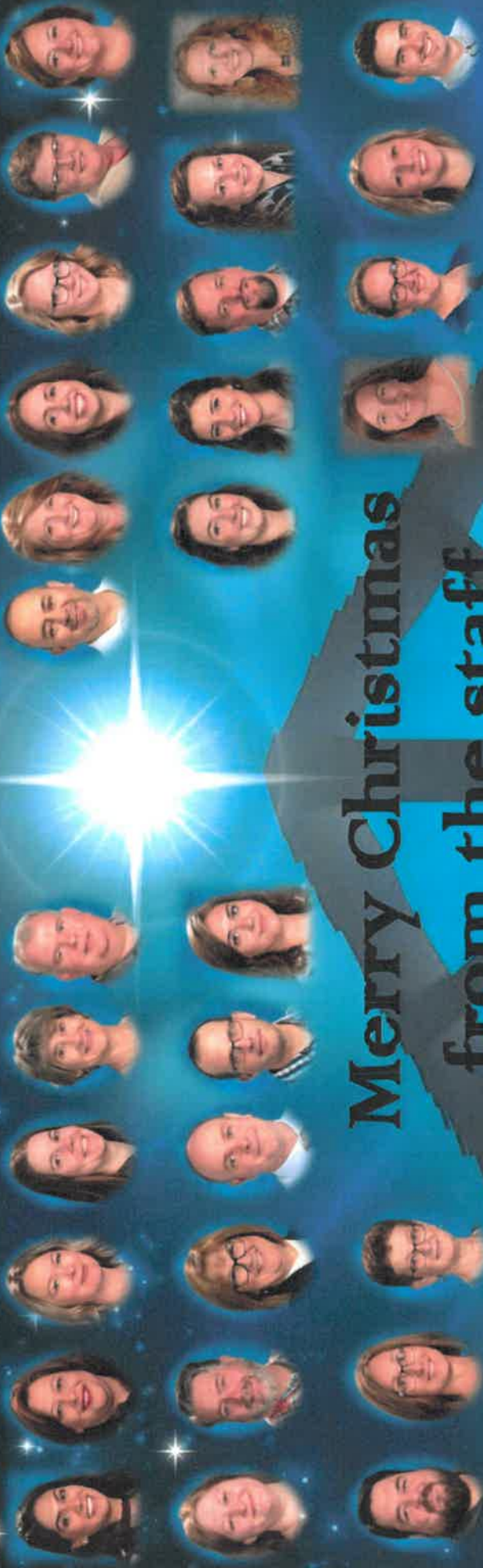

The Grade 9 Girls team is off to a great start, with one win and one hard fought loss. The team this year consists of 13 players. The team is shaping up to be a strong one and will hit the ground running in January with two tournaments and 3 games that month.

The Grade 9 Boys Team are looking to repeat as Zone Champions this year. This season has started with two consecutive wins against the Brooks Junior high, 82-16, and the CTK Royals 61-35. With a significant amount of talent and a motivation to succeed, the boys are surely in for a dominant and successful season. The team heads to their first tournament in Calgary Christian on January 10-11, and they expect big things.





The Sr Girls team started the season with a Silver medal at the Holy Cross tournament. We cruised through our first 2 games of the tournament and after a 7 hour wait we came up against Hanna a significantly more aggressive team in the final. The girls battle hard the whole game and made up a large point difference to finish the game with a 38-37 final score. In league play we are participating in the Senior Southeastern Basketball Conference consisting of all 3A Schools (except us). So far we have played 2 games. I anticipate as the season continues and the girls learn how to work with each other our results will improve.

The JV Boys team - have been having a great year so far and have come a long way in a very short time! The boys are learning and competing with some very good JV teams as well as a few Senior teams! Their attitude is amazing and we will go a long way this year with their fantastic attitude.

The Sr. Boys team has had a great start to the year. We have 14 young men committed to learning, working and practicing to be the best they can be. We have had 4 league games and have a three win/one loss record, losing only to McCoy, a very strong 3A school. We hosted a basketball jamboree with 4 teams on the first weekend in December and won two of three handily, losing one that we would love to play again.



Last weekend we went to Strathmore for a tournament facing many teams in our zone. We were able to win gold with three straight victories in convincing fashion.

Coaches Jeff Haines and Thomas Dyck are excited for the potential that this team shows. With an 8 win and 2 loss record going into the Christmas break, good things seem to be on the horizon for this squad. 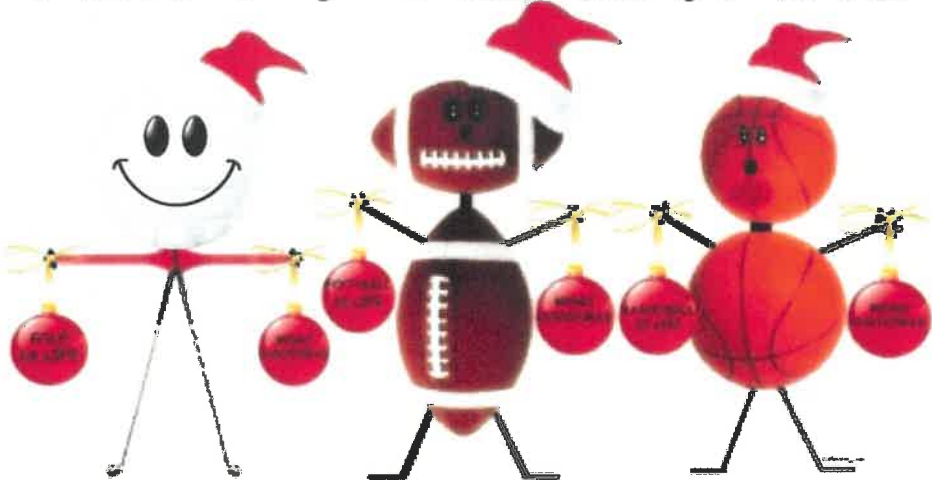
